Additional Cost Examples

Listed below are the potential additional costs that the cadet *may* accrue during the events listed above. These are by no means required, but provided as a courtesy to parents for consideration.

- Woodstock Pool- there is a concession stand at the pool with snacks and drinks available
- Bowling- there is a concession stand and arcade within the bowling alley
- Luray Caverns- costs listed above grant access to the caverns, museums, and Toy Town Junction, however, snacks and souvenirs (to include gem stones) may be purchased at additional cost.
- Skyline Paintball- the cost above includes mask, goggles, gun, and air rental as well as 500 paintballs. However, in the past, some of the cadets ran through 500 paintballs fairly quickly. Cost is \$20 for an additional bag (500) of paintballs and there are snacks/drinks available as well at the service station.
- Hagerstown Suns- cost is for admission only, however, as with any baseball stadium, drinks and snacks are available for purchase as well.
- White Water Rafting- the cost listed covers a 2-3 hour guided white water rafting trip, to include applicable taxes and fees, as well as \$10.00 for meals as the cadets may miss mess between departure and arrival. You may include additional funds for more food if you would like.
- Smithsonian- Both the Smithsonian Museum and National Zoo are free for all ages, we have included the cost listed to pay for meals on the trip.
